Reminder of the Course Selection Process

1. Students have until Friday August 24th to hand in their course selection form to their Care teacher. Students who meet this deadline will be given preference over students who don't when students are allocated to classes for 2019.
2. There is no advantage in handing in the course selection form before August 24th so students should take the full week to consult before making decisions.
3. Students should keep focused on subjects that they really enjoy and subjects that will help prepare them for possible future career pathways that they might be interested in.
4. Students should seek advice of parents/guardians, other adults who know them well and/or people older than them who are in careers that they are interested in.
5. Students should make decisions for the right reasons (in consultation with their parents/guardians) and not just choose subjects because their friends are doing them.
